The Wiki Way to Corpus Analysis: Aspects of Automatic Text Classification

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Abstract. We analyze four different types of document networks with respect to their small world characteristics. These characteristics allow distinguishing wikibased systems from citation and more traditional text networks augmented by hyperlinks. The study provides evidence that a more appropriate network model is needed which better reflects the specifics of wiki systems. It puts emphasize on their topological differences as a result of wiki-related linking compared to other networks. It also emphasizes the consequences of this analysis for text classification and develops an integrative model of content and structure-based classification.
