Collegium Europaeum Gnesense: The conference venue

The main CEG building accommodates lecture halls of various Seating capacities, computer labs and offices. The conference venue offers wireless access to the Internet. All conference rooms are equipped with computers as well as projectors. The CEG campus comprises a student dormitory and a dining-hall. The dormitory consists of 100 beds in single and double rooms, each with a separate bathroom. The campus is located at a 20 minutes walking distance from the Gniezno Cathedral and the city centre.

Coach transfer

Participants who arrive in Poznań on Wednesday (12th September) will be offered a transfer to Gniezno by coach, which will be waiting at the new library building of Collegium Novum. The exact address of Collegium Novum is given below:

Registration will take place at the conference venue in Gniezno.
