NEW Approaches to the Study of Sound Structure and Speech A special session in honour of prof. Katarzyna Dziubalska-Kołaczyk

This special session aims to bring together the contributors to the edited volume **Approaches to the Study of Sound Structure and Speech (eds Wrembel, Kiełkiewicz-Janowiak, Gąsiorowski)** in an attempt to continue the interdisciplinary discussion initiated therein. We hope to provide a state-of-the-art follow-up on a broad range of issues in the study of speech approached from a variety of perspectives, including diachronic, synchronic, theoretical, experimental and applied. The session will offer a discussion of fundamental problems in the field as well as new empirical findings generated from a variety of methodological approaches.

The main goal of the session is to bring together insights from different subdisciplines investigating speech from various perspectives. The organisers of the session welcome the participants of the Festschrift to follow up on the numerous studies they contributed to the volume. The topics include theoretical phonology, acoustic and articulatory phonetics, segmental and suprasegmental phonetics, morphonotactics, historical phonology, speech recognition, language contact, cross-linguistic influence, sociophonetics, foreign language acquisition, L2 pronunciation teaching, and migrant speech. Methodologies of the contributions are likewise diverse, including corpus based studies, diachronic evidence, experimental studies, acoustic studies or online experiments.

We intend to encourage an open debate and an exchange of ideas on the issues involved. The session is also aimed as a high quality scientific endeavour to honour the academic achievements of Professor Katarzyna Dziubalska-Kołaczyk – an outstanding scholar and a charismatic personality. To this end, we intend to bring together renowned scholars in the field, who have collaborated with prof. Katarzyna Dziubalska-Kołaczyk at some point of their academic careers as well as young researchers whom she has inspired.
