**Frequently Asked Questions**

1. When can I apply for conference funding?

You can use conference funding for one conference. The earliest moment you can receive this funding is January 2020. In the conference, you need to deliver a presentation or present a poster directly related to your PhD project. The conference is planned so that you should be able to present research results that will later be part of your PhD thesis. Other conference costs can be covered from funds outside the POWR project.

2. When can I apply for Open Access publication funding?

You can use project funding to pay the fees for Open Access publications. Only the first five **accepted** articles will receive this funding. The articles must be directly related to the research you perform for your PhD project (e.g., reporting research results). The earliest time you can receive this funding is January 2021. One PhD student can receive funding for only one such publication.

3. Does the program provide a computer for working on my PhD project?

Ten computers (five laptops, five PCs) will be at your disposal funded by the POWR project. The computers will be made available at the beginning of the summer semester of the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the PhD studies.

4. What is the planned funding for visits of auxiliary supervisors and PhD students?

**A) Two short visits of auxiliary supervisors (max 5 days).**

Funding scope:

- trip (Europe (max 5): 1500 PLN, USA (max 5): 4000PLN) these costs can be modified depending on the number of trips to the USA
- accommodation (1 night max 250 PLN)

Short visit 1 – April to December 2019

Short visit 2 – April to December 2022

**B) Two short visits of PhD students to auxiliary supervisors (max 5 days).**

Funding scope:

- trip (Europe (5 PhD students): 1500 PLN, USA (5 PhD students): 4000PLN) – these costs can be modified depending on the number of trips to the USA
- daily allowance (220PLN per day)
- visa (max 5 PhD students / 572 PLN per person)
- insurance (17 PLN / 5 day stay)

Short visit 1 – April to December 2019

Short visit 2 – April to December 2021

**C) One long-term visit – October – December 2020 (90 days)**

Funding scope:

- trip (max 2750 PLN) these costs can be modified depending on the number of trips to the USA
- daily allowance (220PLN per day)
- visa for max 5 PhD students (572 PLN per person)
- insurance (17 PLN / 5 day stay)

5. What is the funding for books?

The funding planned for purchase of books is around 2 300 PLN per PhD student. The list of books should be consulted with the supervisors. The deadline for sending the list of books you would like to order is **15 January 2019**.

6. The books you have ordered will be available in the Novum Library (Biblioteka Filologiczna Novum).
