Debra Titone is a professor of psychology at McGill University, Canada, the head of McGill Language and Multilingualism Lab, a member of the Centre for Research on Brain, Language & Music. She is a distinguished expert in research on language processing in monolingual and bilingual speakers. Her program of research focuses on the processing of figurative language (e.g. idioms, metaphors etc.) in healthy as well as disordered populations (e.g. schizophrenia, right hemisphere brain damage patients). In her work she uses a wide range of methods and tools including eye-tracking, EEG and fMRI.
