How to get...?

From the city centre to the conference venue:

The most convenient way to get to the conference venue (**Collegium Biologicum**) from the city centre is by tram (Quick Poznań Tram ‘PESTKA’: 12, 14, 15, 16) and then by bus (98). Trams **12, 14, 15** leave from ‘**Rondo Kaponiera**’ tram stop (direction Os. Sobieskiego). Tram **16** leaves from ‘**Most Teatralny**’ stop (direction Os. Sobieskiego). You need to change to **98** bus at ‘**Os. Sobieskiego**’ stop or just take from there a short walk straight to the venue (see the map above).

From the airport to the city centre:

Poznań Airport (Ławica) is around 8 km from the city centre and is linked with it by the City Public Transport Company (MPK). To get to the centre, take the **48, 59, L, or 242** (night bus) line. All lines stop at ‘**Rondo Kaponiera**’ bus stop. You may also take one of the taxis that are parked in front of the arrival hall.

From the city centre to reception venue:

The most convenient way to get to the reception venue (**Ogród Botaniczny**) from the city centre is by trams **2** or **15**. Both trams leave from ‘**Rondo Kaponiera**’ and stop at ‘**Ogrody**’ tram stop.
